Photography Club – Hands-On Video editing Techniques

Mrs. Noor Ea Thahasin, the Computer Faculty, provided a detailed session on using Windows Movie Maker to create videos. The students were highly engaged and showed great interest as they learned the process of movie creation



Science Club – KREA

The KREA Science Fair held on 23rd November was a remarkable success, showcasing 111 creative projects by students of S4 to S11. It attracted 958 visitors, including 548 parents, 168 students from 3 government schools, 181 students from Periyakottai and MLP campus, 9 alumni and 9 media representatives, creating a vibrant and inclusive atmosphere. The Kreavators projects were judged by three judges lending expertise and credibility. Media coverage further enhanced the school's reputation, while alumni participation fostered a sense of connection and continuity.
