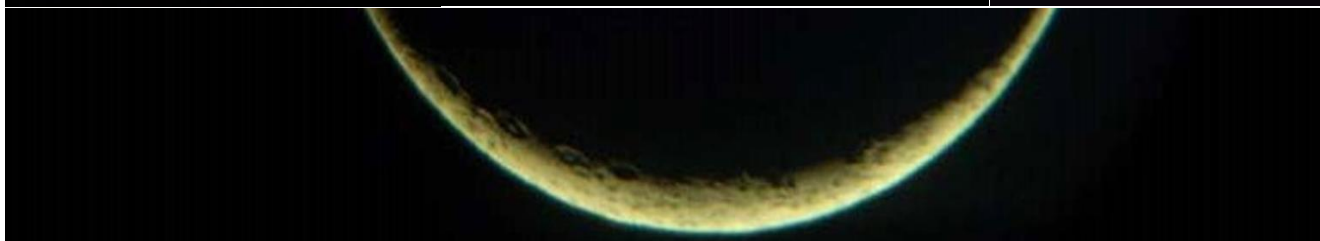
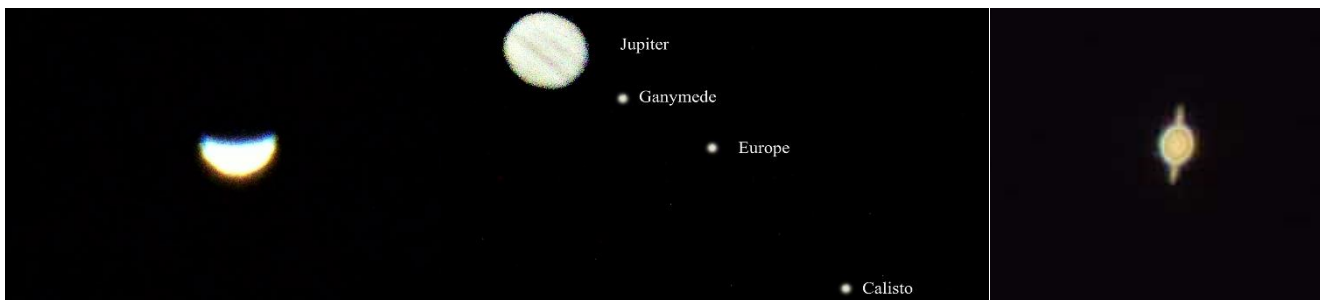
Dance Club – Valli kummi dance at Pongal Celebration 20-1-2025
